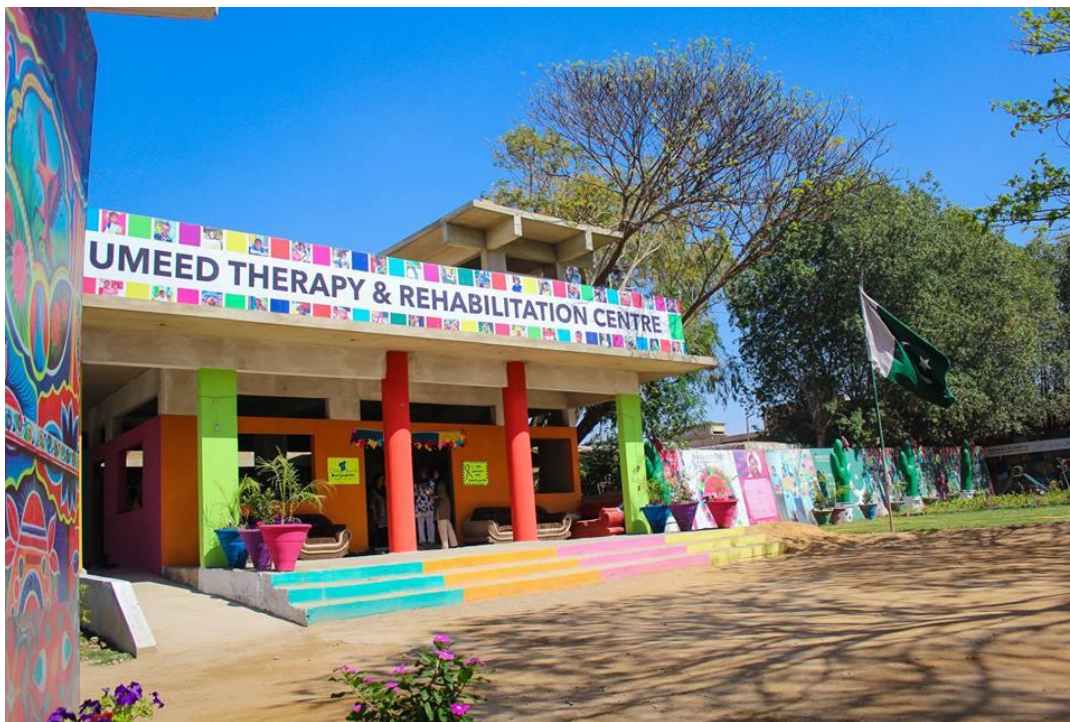
Introduction to Community Service (HS – 200)

Community Service (HS – 200) is a Non-Credit mandatory course for all students studying for their bachelor's degree, as per the requirement set by NED University of Engineering & Technology under University Social Responsibility (USR) Program. Every student must complete at least 16 hours of Community Service at an appropriate place in order to fulfill the requirements. This service helps the university to play its role under the domain of social responsibility as well as making the students realize the on-ground issues/problems that the society faces around them and play an important part in giving back to the community in a positive manner.

Markaz e Umeed for Special Needs Children

Department of Petroleum Engineering collaborated with Markaz e Umeed for Special Needs Children in organizing a community service activity for the students of Petroleum Engineering. Markaz e Umeed for Special Needs Children is a Non-Government Organization (NGO) and has been in operation since 1971 at Karimabad, Karachi. Markaz e Umeed provides the following free of cost services to children with special needs:

- Education for children with special needs
- Skill development
- Vocational trainings
- Therapies i.e., Physiotherapy, Sensational Therapy, and Rehabilitation



Markaz e Umeed is serving the children with special needs by developing some skills according to their abilities so that they afford a reasonable lifestyle and don't depend on their families. Among these efforts, Markaz e Umeed has worked on many special needs children and made them able to earn as well through stitching, food stalls, office works, and cleanliness services at Markaz e Umeed.

Markaz e Umeed has three blocks, i.e., Therapy and Rehabilitation Center, Academic Block, and Occupational Therapy Block. Therapy and rehabilitation center is dedicated for physiotherapy and other therapy practices like psychological therapies. In occupational therapy block, sensational therapies are being practiced for students whose senses are weak.

Academic block is fully dedicated to educate and train the deaf and speech impaired children. They are trained to communicate using lip movements and sign languages. Basic education is also being provided to these kids.

About Community Service Activity:

In total **33 Students** (list is attached at the end) from Department of Petroleum Engineering, NED UET volunteered for the community service activity at Markaz e Umeed. It was a **Two Day** activity where the students volunteered and interacted with children and performed different activities. The activities performed were:





Day 1: Learning Activities (21st February 2024)

Day 1 of the community service was spent interacting with the Director of Markaz e Umeed, Mr. Zeeshan and the management staff, Mr. Saad and Miss Misbah Rana. They briefed the PE students about the motive of Markaz e Umeed and their activities. During first day, PE students performed the following activities:

- Story Telling
- Skill Activities
- Drawing/Writing Activity
- Games

Day 2: Extra Curricular Activities (22nd February 2024)

During the second day at Markaz e Umeed, PE students performed extracurricular activities listed as:

- Cricket
- Singing
- Water painting
- Physical exercises for physically disabled children

All PE students showed great interest in these activities and interacted with children in a well mannered way. They fulfilled all the responsibilities assigned to them by the respective course coordinator Mr. Muhammad Adeem Abbas (PED NED).

With the contribution of PE students, juices were distributed to Markaz e Umeed children. Director Markaz e Umeed, Mr. Zeeshan was overwhelmed with this gratitude of PE students and appreciated them.
